

240 square meter distribution box configuration



Article Overview

A 240 square meter building typically requires a main distribution board with 240V split-phase circuits, sized breakers, and sub-distribution boards for efficient load management.

Main Panel and Voltage Setup

For a 240 m² residential or small commercial building, the main panel is usually 240V split-phase, providing two hot conductors (Hot 1 and Hot 2) and a neutral. The voltage between the two hot conductors is 240V, while each hot to neutral is 120V, allowing both 120V and 240V circuits. The main breaker connects to both hot busbars, and the neutral is bonded to the grounding busbar for safety.

Breaker and Circuit Distribution

- 120V circuits: Single-pole breakers connect one hot busbar to neutral, suitable for lighting, outlets, and small appliances.
- 240V circuits: Two-pole breakers connect both hot busbars, used for high-power appliances like ovens, dryers, water heaters, air conditioners, and motors.
- Breaker sizing: Each breaker should be sized according to the load of the connected appliance or circuit, following NEC or local electrical codes.
