Standard Color Sequence

For an eight-fiber cable, the TIA-598-D standard (widely used in North America and internationally) assigns the following colors to each fiber:

- Blue
- Orange
- Green
- Brown
- Slate (Gray)
- White
- Red
- Black This sequence ensures that each fiber can be uniquely identified during installation, splicing, and maintenance, reducing the risk of miswiring or cross-connections .
