ADSS cables are specifically engineered for aerial deployment alongside high-voltage power lines and utility poles. The term "all-dielectric" indicates that the cable contains no metallic components, ensuring electrical insulation and safety near energized lines, while "self-supporting" means the cable can bear its own weight and withstand environmental loads such as wind, ice, and UV exposure without requiring a messenger wire .

Structure

ADSS cables typically feature:

- Optical fibers housed in loose buffer tubes or central bundle tubes, sometimes arranged in ribbon configurations for high fiber counts .
- Strength members made of aramid yarns or glass fiber reinforced plastic (GRP) to provide tensile strength .
- Outer jacket of UV-resistant polyethylene (HDPE) to protect against moisture, sunlight, and mechanical damage .
