

Ambient temperature requirements during optical cable laying



Article Overview

Optical cables should generally be installed when both the ambient and cable temperatures are above 0–5°C, with prior storage at similar temperatures for at least 24 hours.

Minimum Installation Temperature

For most optical fiber cables, including LSZH-sheathed types, the ambient temperature should not fall below 0–5°C during installation, as low temperatures make the cable stiffer and more prone to cracks or mechanical damage when bent or pulled. If the cable has been stored in cold conditions, it should be kept in a heated environment (around 20°C) for at least 24 hours before installation to allow the cable to reach a safe handling temperature. For very large cable drums, a storage period of up to 48 hours may be necessary.

Handling and Installation Precautions

- **Bending Radius:** Always respect the minimum bend radius specified by the manufacturer. Cold cables are less flexible, and exceeding the bend radius can cause cracks in the sheath or fiber.
- **Mechanical Stress:** Lay the cable carefully, avoiding twisting, kinking, or dragging over rough surfaces. Using a figure-8 pattern can help reduce mechanical stress during deployment.
