A PoE switch is a network switch that delivers both data and electrical power over a single Ethernet cable to connected devices such as IP cameras, wireless access points, and VoIP phones . This eliminates the need for separate power supplies for each device, simplifying network deployment.

They automatically forward traffic and provide power to connected devices without any configuration or monitoring capabilities . They are suitable for small networks or simple deployments where minimal intervention is required.
