Patch panels are intended to complement switches, but sometimes, technicians are concerned that implementing patch panels after a network switch will slow down data. Good news: Patch panels, when implemented correctly, have virtually no effect on the speed of data transmission. In fact, you can use multiple patch panels after a network switch, and.
