

Are fiber optic cables low-voltage lines

Fiber Optic Cables as Low-Voltage Systems

Fiber optic cables are classified under low-voltage cabling because they operate within the low-voltage system category, which generally includes wiring that carries 50 volts or less for communication and control purposes . However, unlike copper cables, fiber optics do not conduct electricity; they transmit information using pulses of light through glass or plastic fibers . This makes them inherently safe, immune to electromagnetic interference, and incapable of delivering electrical power .

Composite Fiber Optic Cables

Some specialized cables, such as Optical Fiber Composite Low-Voltage Cable (OPLC), combine fiber optics with insulated low-voltage power wires. These cables can carry less than 1 kV of electrical power while simultaneously providing high-speed data transmission . Similarly, aerial cables like OPGW (Optical Power Ground Wire) and OPFC (Optical Power Phase Conductor) integrate optical fibers with electrical conductors for utility applications, but the fiber itself remains non-conductive and only the surrounding conductors carry electrical current .

Key Distinctions

- Standard fiber optic cable: Transmits data only, no electrical current, classified as low-voltage for regulatory purposes .
