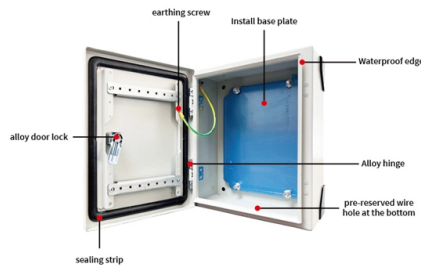


Belgian Fiber Optic Cable Cutover



Overview

As of early 2025, fiber coverage reached about 43% of Belgian homes, with Proximus aiming for 50% by end-2025, 70% by 2028, and 95% by 2032. Proximus FTTH/B offers symmetric speeds up to 8.5 Gbps in some areas as part of its fibre expansion. Over 500,000 fixed high-speed connections were established using fibre optic technology by the end of 2024, marking a significant milestone for the first time, according to the latest annual report from the Belgian Institute for Postal Services and Telecommunications (BIPT) revealed on Wednesday.
