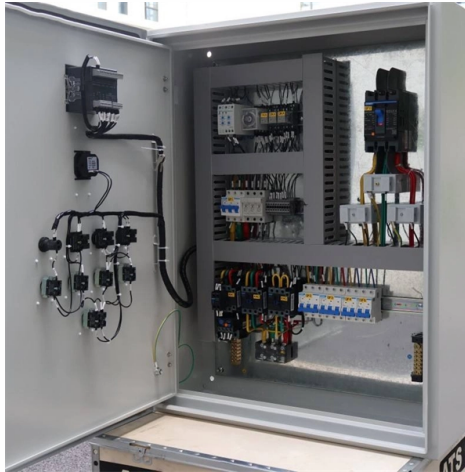

- Armored cables (e.g., GYTA53): Can be buried directly without conduit due to steel tape and water-blocking protection, typically at 1.0-1.5 meters (100-150 cm) in rural or high-risk areas .
- Unarmored cables: Require conduits and are usually buried at 0.6-0.9 meters (60-90 cm) in urban areas .
