Standard Elbow Dimensions

Cable tray elbows are designed to match the nominal width and height of straight tray sections. Standard widths and heights typically include:

- Widths (W): 150 mm, 203 mm, 300 mm, 450 mm, 600 mm, 750 mm, 900 mm
- Heights (H): 50 mm, 70 mm, 100 mm, 120 mm Elbows are manufactured to maintain the same internal spacing as straight sections, allowing continuous cable support and proper bend radius.

Elbow Radii and Angles

Elbows are available in multiple radii and angles to accommodate different installation requirements:

- Radii: 305 mm, 610 mm, 915 mm, 1220 mm
- Angles: 30°, 45°, 60°, 90° These options allow designers to select the appropriate bend for cable type, load, and space constraints, minimizing stress on cables and ensuring compliance with electrical codes.

- Material: Steel (pre-galvanized, hot-dip galvanized), aluminum (6063-T5), stainless steel (316L)
