

Cable organizer door cannot be closed after installation



Overview

The issue is this chassis is not designed for cable management in the right hand side. Is there a way I can keep that door closed?

Overlapping cables are probably the problem, especially over the 24 pin. RE cable manage case in a way has the absolute least cable overlap, especially with the 24 pin (I almost never get any cable to over lap. I have what I believe is a standard Novatech Midi Tower Case, and I tried to manage my cables for a future SSD upgrade, but now I cannot close the side of the case with the cables poking through: So what are my options?

Is it OK to leave the cover off, or should I attempt to squash down the cables?

I am highly anti-dust, and my compute side panel cannot close due to plugs from the HDD protruding too far for the panel to close. Yes, if you want to change the.
