

Cable tray construction through walls



Article Overview

Cable trays passing through walls must be properly supported, sealed with fire-rated materials, and installed to maintain structural and fire safety compliance.

Planning and Layout

When routing cable trays through walls, it is essential to align the tray with the building structure and avoid unnecessary detours or interference with other utilities. The opening in the wall should be slightly larger than the tray dimensions, typically about 6 inches larger than the tray's outside dimensions, to allow for fireproofing materials and installation clearance (). Ensure that power and signal cables are segregated to minimize electromagnetic interference ().

Material Selection

Choose tray materials based on the environment:

- Indoor: Painted steel or galvanized steel trays
- Outdoor: Hot-dip galvanized or stainless steel trays
- Corrosive or high-humidity areas: Aluminum alloy or fiberglass-reinforced plastic trays () The tray must have sufficient mechanical strength to support the cable load without deformation.

Fireproofing and Sealing

Firestopping is critical when cable trays penetrate walls:

- Use UL-classified fire sealant bags or pillows, such as Grace KBS Sealbags or 3M Fire Barrier Pillows, installed according to manufacturer instructions ().
