

Cable tray selection requirements and standards



Article Overview

Cable tray selection must comply with IEC 61537, NEC 392, and NEMA VE 1 standards, considering cable type, load, environment, and installation safety.

Key Considerations for Cable Tray Selection

1. Cable Type and Volume Determine the number, type, and size of cables to be supported. High-voltage power cables, low-voltage control cables, and fiber optic cables may require different tray types and segregation to prevent interference and overheating . 2. Environmental Conditions Assess whether the installation is indoor or outdoor, exposure to moisture, chemicals, extreme temperatures, or corrosive environments. Material selection (steel, stainless steel, aluminum, or fiberglass) and protective coatings must match environmental demands . 3. Load Capacity and Span Select trays that can safely support the weight of cables without sagging. IEC 61537 and NEMA VE 1 provide load/span class designations. Proper mechanical strength ensures durability under cable weight and external forces . 4. Regulatory Compliance Ensure compliance with:

- IEC 61537: International standard for metal and nonmetallic cable trays, covering construction, testing, performance, electrical continuity, fire resistance, and ventilation .
 - NEC Article 392: Governs cable tray installations in the U.S., including fill limits, grounding, and installation practices .
 - NEMA VE 1 & CSA C22.2: Define manufacturing requirements, load/span classes, and installation guidelines for metal trays .
