

Cable tray through-wall construction standards



Article Overview

Cable trays passing through walls must comply with NEC, NEMA, and fireproofing standards, ensuring proper sealing, grounding, and mechanical support.

Regulatory Requirements

NEC Article 392 governs cable tray installations in the U.S., including through-wall applications. Key points include:

- **Accessibility:** Cable trays must remain accessible and cannot be permanently enclosed within walls or hoistways. Openings through walls require proper fire-stopping to prevent fire spread .
- **Cable Types:** Only use conductors rated for open-air environments, such as Tray Rated (Type TC) or Metal-Clad (Type MC) cables .
- **Separation:** High-power and low-power cables must be separated to prevent electromagnetic interference (EMI), .
- **Fill Limits:** Power cables should not exceed 40% of the tray's cross-sectional area; control cables can occupy up to 50% .
- **Grounding:** Metallic trays can serve as equipment grounding conductors if installed according to NEC requirements .
