

Cable trays and cable tray wiring

Cable trays support a variety of wiring methods, including service conductors, feeders, branch circuits, communications, control, and signaling circuits, with installation governed by NEC Article 392.

Types of Wiring Methods

Cable trays are designed to carry multiple types of electrical and communication wiring:

- **Service Conductors and Feeders:** These include single or multi-conductor cables that supply power to equipment or distribution panels. Single conductors sized 1/0 AWG to 4/0 AWG are commonly used, with maximum rung spacing of 9 inches for proper support (NEC 392.10(B)(1)(c)), .
- **Branch Circuits:** Smaller power circuits can also be routed through cable trays, provided they comply with fill and support requirements.
- **Control and Signaling Circuits:** Low-voltage control wiring, instrumentation, and signaling cables can be installed in the same tray, often separated from higher-voltage cables if necessary.
- **Communication Circuits:** Optical fiber and other communication cables can share the tray with power cables, but cables above 600 volts must be separated by a solid barrier from lower-voltage cables .

Installation Practices

- **Securing Cables:** Cables must be fastened at intervals according to manufacturer instructions to prevent sagging or movement.
