

Cable trays with intermediate gaps

Cable trays with intermediate gaps are supported at intervals to allow airflow, heat dissipation, and flexible cable management while maintaining structural integrity.

Understanding Intermediate Gaps

Intermediate gaps in cable tray systems refer to the spaces between support points or tray sections. These gaps are designed to:

- Reduce material usage and installation costs
- Allow air circulation around cables, improving heat dissipation
- Facilitate easy access for maintenance, inspection, and cable additions
- Accommodate thermal expansion and contraction of trays and cables The spacing between supports depends on the tray type, material, cable weight, and environmental conditions. Ladder-type trays, for example, can span longer distances due to their rigid cross-member design, while wire mesh or perforated trays may require closer support to prevent sagging .

Recommended Support Intervals

- Ladder trays: Typically supported every 1.5 to 3 meters (5-10 feet) depending on load and cable type .
- Perforated trays: Support intervals are usually shorter, around 1 to 2 meters (3-6 feet), to maintain stability and prevent excessive deflection .
