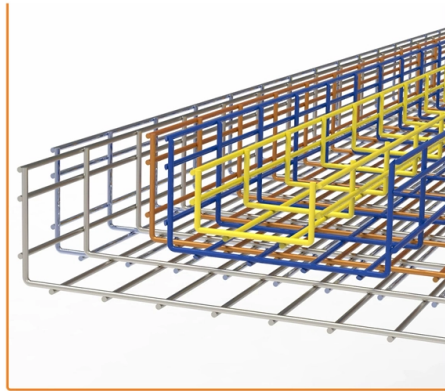


Can I use a fiber optic cable directly after connecting it to a router

A standard home router cannot directly accept a fiber optic cable; an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) is required to convert the fiber signal into Ethernet for the router.

Why Direct Connection Isn't Possible

Fiber optic cables transmit data as pulses of light through glass or plastic strands, whereas standard home routers use Ethernet ports that carry electrical signals over copper wiring. The connectors and signal types are fundamentally incompatible, making it physically and electrically impossible to plug a fiber cable directly into a typical router's RJ45 port (Ethernet) .

Standard Setup with an ONT

- **Fiber Termination at ONT:** The fiber line from your ISP terminates at an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), usually installed near where the fiber enters your home. The ONT converts the optical signal into a standard electrical signal that your router can interpret .
- **Router Connection:** After conversion, the ONT provides an Ethernet output. You connect this output to your router's WAN or Internet port using a high-quality Ethernet cable (Cat6 or higher recommended for optimal speeds) .
- **Power and Configuration:** Both the ONT and router require power. Once connected, the router can be configured with your ISP credentials to establish internet access .
