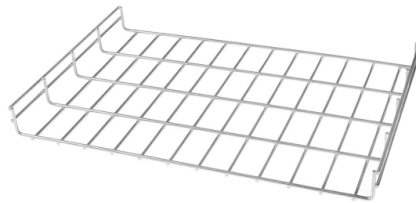


Can a fiber optic cable be connected to a single-mode cable



Overview

Multimode fiber and single-mode fiber can be connected, but the signal loss is very large, so they are generally not connected. If an individual wants to connect to a telecommunications fiber optic cable, it is recommended to lay a new single-mode fiber. Although they can do the same job in some instances, the different construction methods make each of them better suited to certain tasks and budgets. How it works: A media converter has two ports: one for SMF and one for MMF. It uses single-mode propagation – the light travels at a single wavelength within the fiber core. This avoids interference between wavelengths. The core is only 810 micrometers in diameter, making it much smaller than a multi-mode fiber.
