Overview

When dealing with a point-to-point fiber optic connection from an ISP, you can't simply split the connection among multiple devices. Each device would require its own dedicated connection to avoid interference. This is where a switch comes in.

The easiest way to do is, terminate your ISP connection to single router with at least 2 independent LAN interfaces, then you can build 2 separate networks there.
