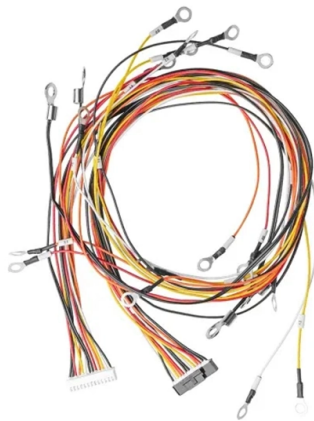


Can fiber optic cables and routers be connected

Fiber optic cables can be connected to routers, but typically require an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) or a fiber-ready router with an SFP port to convert optical signals into electrical signals.

How Fiber Optic Connections Work

Fiber optic cables transmit data as pulses of light through glass or plastic fibers, offering high-speed, low-latency internet. Standard home routers cannot interpret these optical signals directly. To bridge this gap, an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) is used. The ONT converts the incoming light signals from the fiber into electrical signals that a router can process via an Ethernet connection .

Direct Connection Options

Some modern routers are fiber-ready and include an SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) port or a dedicated fiber WAN port. In these cases, the fiber cable can be connected directly to the router without an ONT, but this is less common in typical home setups . Most ISPs still provide an ONT as part of the installation.

Step-by-Step Connection

- Install the ONT: Connect the fiber cable from the wall outlet to the ONT's optical port. Power on the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize .
- Connect ONT to Router: Use an Ethernet cable to link the ONT's LAN port to the router's WAN port. Power on the router and confirm connectivity via indicator lights .
