1. Circuit Overloading

The most frequent cause of breaker trips is overloading, which occurs when the total electrical demand on a circuit exceeds its rated capacity. This often happens when multiple high-power appliances, such as microwaves, ovens, hair dryers, or HVAC systems, operate simultaneously on the same circuit. Overloads generate heat in the wiring, triggering the breaker to trip to prevent damage or fire. Calculating the total connected load and redistributing devices across circuits can help prevent repeated trips .

2. Short Circuits

A short circuit happens when a hot wire touches a neutral or another hot wire, creating a sudden surge of electricity. This can produce sparks, a burning smell, or even melted insulation near outlets. Short circuits are hazardous because they can cause fires almost instantly, and they require immediate attention from a licensed electrician .
