China Telecom fiber optic service typically requires the use of operator-provided ONTs, which can limit the use of third-party routers without proper configuration.

ONT and FTTR Deployment

China Telecom, like other major Chinese operators, is expanding Fiber to the Room (FTTR) technology, which extends fiber directly into individual rooms to ensure consistent gigabit speeds and reduce Wi-Fi congestion . In this setup, a centralized ONT is installed in the home, and additional sub-ONTs or Wi-Fi access points are deployed in each room. These ONTs are often optimized for the operator's network and may include integrated Wi-Fi 6 or 6E capabilities .

Router Compatibility and Restrictions

- **Operator-provided ONTs:** China Telecom generally requires its ONT to authenticate with the network. This means that simply connecting a third-party router may not provide full service unless the ONT is configured in bridge mode or the router supports PPPoE login with the credentials provided by the operator .
- **Wi-Fi handover:** FTTR solutions, such as Huawei's, allow seamless roaming between ONTs or APs using the same SSID, which can be disrupted if a third-party router is used improperly .
- **Performance considerations:** Using a non-operator router may reduce throughput or prevent access to certain services like IPTV or VoIP, which rely on VLAN tagging or QoS settings configured on the ONT .
