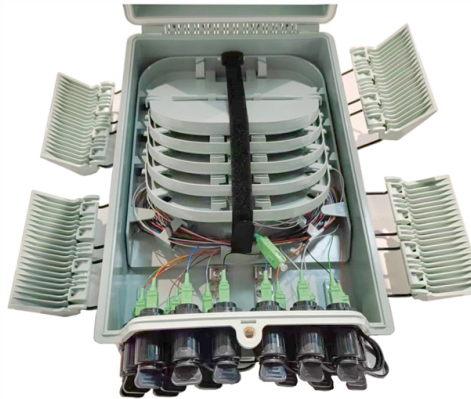


Circuit switch distribution box neutral connection terminal



Article Overview

The neutral connection terminal, or neutral bus bar, in a distribution box serves as the common return path for all neutral wires from branch circuits, ensuring safe and organized current flow back to the supply.

Purpose of the Neutral Terminal

The neutral terminal (neutral bus bar or neutral link) is a conductive metal bar, usually made of copper or aluminum, that collects all neutral wires from individual circuits and connects them back to the supply neutral conductor (). It provides a return path for current in AC circuits, completing the electrical loop from the load back to the source (). In main panels, the neutral bus is bonded to the ground bus, while in subpanels it must remain isolated from the ground to prevent unwanted current paths ().

Wiring Practices

- Single-Pole MCBs: Only the phase (live) wire passes through the MCB. The neutral wire from the load is connected directly to the neutral bus bar ().
- Double-Pole or 1P+N MCBs: Both phase and neutral wires pass through the breaker. The neutral from the supply connects to the breaker input, and the load neutral connects to the breaker output. Any remaining neutral wires are connected to the neutral bus ().
- RCCB or RCD: The neutral from the supply is connected to the RCCB input, and the output neutral is routed to the neutral bus for distribution to branch circuits ().
