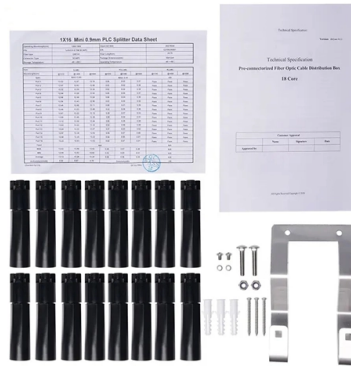


# Classification of Fiberglass Cable Trays

### Solid Bottom Cable Tray

Solid bottom trays have a fully closed bottom and continuous side walls, offering the highest level of protection against dust, liquids, and mechanical damage. They are commonly used in commercial buildings, tunnels, and transportation projects, often combined with cover plates to form an enclosed cable duct. This type is ideal where cables must be completely isolated from the environment .
