A secondary distribution box must be properly rated, safely installed, correctly wired, and equipped with protective devices to ensure reliable power distribution and compliance with electrical standards.

Enclosure and Environmental Requirements

- **Type and Material:** Choose a box suitable for the environment—steel for durability in industrial or outdoor settings, plastic for indoor use. The enclosure should have an appropriate IP or NEMA rating to protect against dust, moisture, and impact .
- **Placement:** Install in a dry, ventilated, and accessible area, typically at a height of 1.5–1.8 meters for ease of operation and inspection . Avoid humid, corrosive, or flammable environments unless using explosion-proof enclosures .
- **Mounting:** Secure the box firmly using brackets or screws to prevent movement or tilting due to vibration or accidental impact .

Electrical Configuration

- **Power Source:** The SDB receives power from the main distribution box via an extender cable and distributes it to branch circuits .
- **Internal Components:** Include terminal blocks, busbars, neutral and earth bars, MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, fuses, isolators, and surge protective devices as required by the application .
