Step 1: Prepare and Clean the Connectors

Before connecting, inspect and clean the fiber ends. Use lint-free wipes and fiber cleaning pens to remove dust, oil, or debris from the ferrules. Never touch the connector tips with bare hands, as contamination can cause signal loss or reflection .

Step 2: Identify Connector Types

Determine the type of connectors on your two-core cables, such as LC, SC, ST, or MPO. Ensure that the connectors are compatible; mismatched types (e.g., APC to UPC) can lead to reflection and signal degradation .

Step 3: Use Adapters and Patch Cords

Inside cabinets or patch panels, the recommended method is to use fiber adapters and patch cords rather than splicing directly. The typical connection structure is: Cable A → Adapter Panel → Patch Cord → Adapter Panel → Cable B

- Adapters align and join the connectors, bridging different types if necessary (e.g., LC to SC).
- Patch cords provide a flexible link, allowing easy maintenance and reconfiguration . Insert the connectors gently into the adapter, ensuring they click or lock securely in place.
