

Connect a single-mode fiber optic transceiver to one



Article Overview

To connect a single-mode fiber optic transceiver, insert the transceiver into the device port, remove dust caps, and connect compatible single-mode fiber cables with matching connectors and wavelengths.

Step 1: Verify Compatibility

Before installation, ensure the SFP transceiver and fiber cable are compatible in terms of:

- Fiber type: Single-mode fiber (SMF) with a 9/125 μ m core
- Connector type: Commonly LC or ST connectors for single-mode SFPs
- Wavelength: Typically 1310nm or 1550nm for long-distance transmission
- Data rate: Match the transceiver's supported speed (e.g., 1G, 10G) with the network device .

Step 2: Prepare the Transceiver and Device

- Power off the device if required, though most SFPs are hot-swappable
- Remove the dust cap from the SFP transceiver and set it aside for future use
- Wear an anti-static wrist strap or use grounded tools to prevent ESD damage
