

Connecting the optical ports of switches and routers



Article Overview

To connect a router to a switch via an optical port, you typically use compatible fiber transceivers (SFP modules) in both devices and link them with a matching fiber optic cable.

Step 1: Verify Hardware Compatibility

Ensure both your router and switch support fiber connections. Most modern switches have SFP or SFP+ ports for fiber, while some routers may require an SFP module or a dedicated fiber WAN port. Check the device manuals for supported transceiver types (e.g., LC connectors, multi-mode or single-mode fiber) and speeds (1G, 10G, etc.), .

Step 2: Install Fiber Transceivers

Insert the SFP modules into the fiber ports of both the router and the switch. Make sure the modules are compatible with each other and with the fiber type you plan to use. For short distances, multi-mode fiber is usually sufficient and more cost-effective, while single-mode fiber is used for longer runs .

Step 3: Connect the Fiber Cable

Use a fiber optic patch cable with matching connectors (commonly LC-LC) to link the router and switch. Ensure transmit (TX) on one end connects to receive (RX) on the other. Avoid bending the fiber sharply, as this can damage the cable and degrade signal quality .
