

Connection of explosion-proof conduit to distribution box



Article Overview

Conduits for explosion-proof distribution boxes must be connected using certified fittings with sealed joints to prevent flame propagation, following strict standards and safety protocols.

Conduit Connection Principles

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Use of Certified Fittings: All conduits must connect to the distribution box through special certified fittings designed for Ex d (flameproof) enclosures. These fittings prevent sparks or flames from escaping the box into the hazardous environment .

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Sealed Joints: A sealing fitting is installed between the box and the conduit. Once sealed with special resins, it prevents the transmission of flames through the conduit in case of an internal explosion .

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Pipe Material and Standards: Steel pipes are commonly used, smooth inside, and compliant with IEC 60614-2-1 standards. Pipes must be free of welded seams or internal irregularities that could damage cables . Galvanized steel pipes are preferred, and they should undergo static pressure testing (40 bar before curves, 20 bar after curves for 5 seconds) to ensure integrity .
