

Construction plan for direct burial of optical fiber cables



Article Overview

Direct-buried optical fiber cables require careful planning, trenching or plowing, protective bedding, proper depth, and adherence to safety and technical standards to ensure long-term performance.

Planning and Design

Before installation, conduct a route survey to identify obstacles, soil conditions, and potential hazards. Determine cable lengths based on splice locations and include slack for splicing and future maintenance . Mark all splice points and handholes in advance to minimize open trench time and reduce safety risks . Ensure compliance with local, state, and federal codes, as well as manufacturer specifications .

Cable Selection

Choose a direct-burial rated cable, which may include:

- Loose-tube, gel-filled or gel-free for long outdoor runs, protecting fibers from water and microbending .
- Armored cables with metal layers for high mechanical risk areas like road crossings or rocky soil .
- Tight-buffered or breakout-style cables for easy termination near buildings .
