

Core Switch Mirror Port Branch

A core switch mirror port can capture branch switch traffic using local or remote port mirroring, sending it to a monitoring device for analysis.

Understanding Port Mirroring

Port mirroring duplicates network traffic from one or more source ports to a designated mirror (destination) port for monitoring purposes. This allows administrators to analyze traffic without affecting live network flows. Mirroring can be local (source and destination on the same switch) or remote (source and destination on different switches) depending on network topology and monitoring needs .

- Local Port Mirroring: Traffic from branch switch ports is mirrored to a destination port on the same switch. Simple to configure but limited to a single switch.
- Remote Port Mirroring (RSPAN/ERPM): Traffic from branch switches is sent across uplinks to a core switch mirror port. This allows centralized monitoring of multiple branch locations .

Configuration Steps

- Identify Source Ports: Determine which branch switch ports or VLANs need monitoring. This could include servers, workstations, or uplinks to the core switch .
- Select Destination Port: Choose an unused port on the core switch to act as the mirror port. Connect this port to a monitoring device such as a packet analyzer or IDS .
- Configure Mirroring on Branch Switches:
- Enable port mirroring on the source ports.
