I'm working on a setup with two core switches (Core 1 and Core 2) running MLAG for redundancy and load balancing, and I've hit a weird problem with STP and MAC addresses. Hoping someone here can point me in the right direction. Core 1 and Core 2 are configured with MLAG (Multi-Chassis Link. Core Switch were sending packets with incorrect destination MAC address towards Access switch - it was due to some bug. But my question is not about that bug. The thing is, that destination MAC really belongs to existed host connected to another access switch and it was in another VLAN than host. MAC flaps/loops are disruptions in a network caused by inconsistencies in the MAC address tables of switches.
