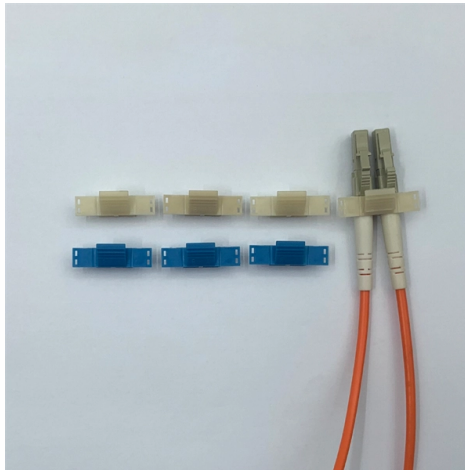


Correct Use of Secondary Distribution Box

A secondary distribution box (subpanel) safely redistributes power from the main panel to localized circuits, ensuring organized, reliable, and code-compliant electrical distribution.

Purpose and Function

A secondary distribution box, or subpanel, acts as a satellite distribution point that receives power from the main electrical panel and distributes it to specific areas, such as a garage, basement, or workshop . It does not generate power but allows for additional circuits without running long wires back to the main panel, improving efficiency and organization .

Key Components

A typical secondary distribution box includes:

- Circuit Breakers: Protect individual circuits from overloads and short circuits .
- Residual Current Circuit Breaker (RCCB): Detects imbalances between phase conductors to prevent electric shocks .
- Bus Bars: Conduct electricity within the box and serve as central connection points for circuits .
- Neutral and Grounding Bars: Ensure proper return paths and safety grounding .
- Enclosure: Protects internal components from physical damage, dust, and moisture .
