

Dimensions of cable tray cuts



Article Overview

Standard cable tray dimensions typically range from 50mm to 1000mm in width, 25mm to 150mm in height, and 3 meters in length, with material thickness varying by load requirements.

Standard Widths and Heights

Cable tray widths are the primary factor determining cable capacity. Common nominal widths include 100mm, 200mm, 300mm, 450mm, 600mm, and up to 1000mm, depending on the number and type of cables to be routed . Heights, also referred to as side rail heights or tray depths, generally range from 25mm to 150mm, with deeper trays used for heavy power cables and shallower trays for control or data cables . The width and height must comply with NEC, IEC, and NEMA standards to ensure proper cable fill, ventilation, and heat dissipation .

Length and Material Thickness

Cable trays are typically manufactured in 3-meter (10-foot) sections, which simplifies transport and installation . Material thickness varies according to load capacity and tray type: light-duty trays may have thinner walls, while heavy-duty trays require 2.5mm or more thickness with reinforced side rails for structural support . Galvanized trays must meet ASTM A653 standards for corrosion resistance.

Calculating Tray Size

To determine the correct tray dimensions for a project:

- Calculate total cable cross-sectional area using manufacturer specifications.
