

Distance between communication optical cables and power lines



Article Overview

Minimum separation distances depend on voltage, installation type, and EMI considerations, typically ranging from 2 inches (50 mm) for low-voltage indoor runs to 50 cm or more for high-voltage parallel runs.

Minimum Safety Distances

For indoor low-voltage installations (e.g., 230–400V), the National Electrical Code (NEC) and UK standards recommend a minimum of 50 mm (2 inches) between communication cables and power lines to prevent insulation failure and accidental contact, especially for parallel runs. In some cases, distances up to 150 mm may be required depending on cable type and EMC considerations (BS 6701, BS EN 50174-2). For parallel runs of medium-to-high voltage lines, industry guidelines suggest 8 inches (20 cm) as a baseline, increasing to 50 cm or more for high-voltage circuits to reduce electromagnetic interference (EMI). When cables cross each other, a perpendicular 90-degree crossing is recommended, which minimizes parallel exposure and reduces the required separation.

Outdoor and Buried Installations

For buried communication cables, a radial separation of 12–24 inches (300–600 mm) from power supply cables is generally recommended to ensure safety, ease of locating, and compliance with NESC rules. Depth of burial also varies with voltage: for example, low-voltage supply cables may be buried at 18–24 inches, while higher-voltage lines require deeper burial up to 42 inches (1,070 mm).
