

Distance between mesh cable tray supports



Article Overview

Supports for mesh cable trays should generally be spaced between 1.5 and 2.5 meters (approximately 5 to 8 feet), depending on load and manufacturer specifications.

Recommended Spacing

For wire mesh cable trays, the typical support spacing is 1.5 to 2.5 meters apart, ensuring the tray remains level and can safely carry the weight of the cables without sagging or deformation (CMW), . The exact spacing should always follow the manufacturer's load ratings and installation guidelines to account for the specific tray type, cable weight, and environmental conditions (Zexin Electrical), .

Factors Affecting Support Placement

- **Load and Cable Weight:** Heavier cables or high-density installations may require closer support spacing to prevent excessive deflection (LinkedIn), .
- **Tray Type:** Ladder, trough, and mesh trays have different structural strengths; mesh trays are lightweight but require careful support placement to maintain stability (YDX Cable Tray), .
- **Environmental Conditions:** Outdoor installations, seismic zones, or areas with vibration may necessitate shorter spans and additional safety factors (YDX Cable Tray), .
- **Vertical Runs:** Supports for vertical sections should be placed at intervals not exceeding 1.5 meters to maintain stability (LinkedIn), .
