- Detect DC arc faults in PV strings and interrupt the circuit to prevent potential fires.
- Aggregate multiple PV string inputs into a single output, simplifying wiring and monitoring.
- Provide system isolation for maintenance or emergency situations.
- Enable real-time monitoring of current, voltage, and fault conditions to ensure early detection of hazards .
- Fireman Switch / Emergency Shutdown
- Automatically disconnects PV modules from the grid when firefighters switch off the building's power supply.
