Trunking is often preferred in offices, schools, and healthcare facilities where aesthetics and safety are priorities.

Typical Applications

- Cable trays are widely used in industrial plants, warehouses, data centers, and commercial buildings, where large volumes of cables need to be managed efficiently and remain accessible for modifications.
- Cable trunking is used where concealment and visual neatness are important, such as in residential or office environments.
