Distribution Box

A distribution box, also called a distribution board or panel, is an electrical enclosure that receives power from the main supply and distributes it to multiple outgoing circuits through protective devices such as MCBs, RCDs, fuses, and busbars . Its main functions include:

- Power distribution: Divides incoming electricity into smaller circuits for lighting, appliances, or machinery.
- Protection: Houses circuit breakers and fuses to prevent overloads, short circuits, and earth faults.
- Organization: Provides a structured layout for wiring, terminals, and busbars, improving maintenance efficiency.
- Applications: Used in homes, offices, industrial facilities, infrastructure projects, and renewable energy systems . Distribution boxes can be indoor or outdoor, made of metal or plastic, and are selected based on the number of circuits, rated current, short-circuit capacity, and environmental conditions .
