

Does the distribution box supply power

A distribution box does not generate power; it receives electricity from a main source and safely distributes it to multiple circuits.

How a Distribution Box Works

A distribution box, also called a distribution board, power distribution unit (PDU), or DB box, acts as the central hub of an electrical system. It receives electrical power from the main supply—such as a utility line, generator, or building feed—and then splits it into multiple circuits that supply different areas or devices within a home, office, or industrial facility (E-Abel, KUPO Power, GEYA) . Inside the box, components like circuit breakers, fuses, bus bars, and residual current devices (RCDs) ensure that electricity is distributed safely. These devices protect against overloads, short circuits, and electrical surges, automatically shutting off affected circuits if a fault occurs, while keeping the rest of the system operational (Demiks Power, Saipwell) .

Key Functions

- **Power Distribution:** Directs electricity from a single input source to multiple branch circuits efficiently.
- **Safety:** Prevents damage to equipment and reduces the risk of electrical hazards by monitoring current flow and tripping circuits when necessary.
- **Organization:** Provides a structured and accessible way to manage electrical connections, making maintenance and troubleshooting easier.
- **Load Management:** Balances electrical loads across circuits to prevent overloading any single wire or device.
