When mounting a box directly to a wood stud, a coarse-threaded wood screw or specialized nail is commonly used, typically ranging from 1 1/4 to 2 inches in length. This ensures sufficient thread engagement and shear strength into the lumber to prevent the box from shifting. Some boxes also include DIN rails for mounting extra devices and cable entry points to keep wires neat. These extras help make the box easier to install and maintain.
