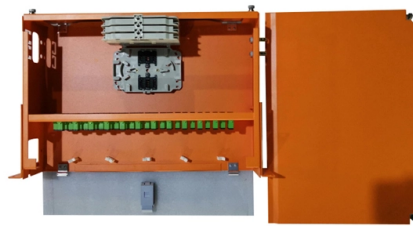


Emergency Lighting Installation in Distribution Boxes

Emergency lighting in distribution boxes must be installed according to safety standards, ensuring automatic operation, independent power supply, and proper monitoring for safe evacuation.

Key Considerations for Installation

1. Power Supply and Switching: Emergency lighting must switch automatically from the normal supply to an auxiliary or backup source when the main power fails. The changeover should occur within 0.5 seconds if the supply voltage drops below 60% of the rated voltage, and normal operation should resume when voltage exceeds 85% of the rated value . Distribution boxes should provide dual independent feeds to minimize the risk of simultaneous failure . 2. System Types:

- Self-contained luminaires: Each light has its own battery backup, suitable for smaller installations or retrofits .
