

Enhancing the safety of optical cables



Article Overview

Enhancing fiber optic security involves combining physical protection, encryption, intrusion detection, and robust network management to prevent unauthorized access and data breaches.

Physical Security Measures

Fiber optic cables are inherently more secure than copper due to their use of light signals, which are difficult to tap without detection. However, physical tampering remains a risk. To mitigate this:

- Use armored or hardened cables in high-risk areas, underground, or in outdoor installations to prevent damage and unauthorized access .
- Deploy secure enclosures for distribution frames, terminals, and junctions to restrict physical access .
- Implement surveillance and monitoring systems in areas where fiber is installed to detect tampering or intrusion attempts .
- Regular inspections and maintenance ensure cables remain intact and any breaches are quickly identified .
- Color-coded cables, such as vivid orange, can act as a visual deterrent and help administrators quickly spot potential issues .

Even with physical security, data transmitted over fiber should be encrypted to prevent interception:
