1. Power Isolation: Before starting, ensure the electrical power supply is completely turned off by isolating the circuit at the main breaker to prevent electrocution or accidental sparks .
2. Cable Selection: Use cables rated for hazardous areas, typically marked with EX or ATEX certification. These cables should be flame-resistant, impact-resistant, and mechanically durable to prevent sparks or arcs from escaping the box .
3. Terminal Connections:
 - Open the terminal chamber cover and route cables through the cable glands.
 - Connect the incoming power supply to the designated terminals for live, neutral, and earth wires.
 - Ensure all connections are tight and secure, using a multimeter or continuity tester to verify correctness .
 - Match wire cross-sections to switch terminals and bundle secondary wiring neatly with nylon tape .
4. Grounding: Proper grounding is critical. Connect the earth conductor to the dedicated earth terminal to safely direct stray currents and prevent fire or shock hazards .
