Causes of Obstruction

Large distribution boxes may become obstructed due to:

- Improper installation location: Placing the box too high, too low, or in cramped spaces can make access difficult for operation and maintenance, and may violate safety codes .
- Environmental constraints: Walls, furniture, or other equipment can block access, reducing the ability to inspect, repair, or replace components .
- Internal overcrowding: Excessive wiring, poorly arranged busbars, or insufficient DIN rail space can create internal obstruction, making it hard to connect or disconnect circuits safely .

Safety and Operational Implications

Obstructed distribution boxes can lead to:

- Maintenance hazards: Limited access increases the risk of accidental contact with live parts and makes routine inspections or cleaning difficult .
- Overheating: Restricted airflow inside or around the box can reduce heat dissipation, accelerating component aging and increasing fire risk .
