Overview of FC Connectors

The FC connector is a fiber-optic interface featuring a threaded body that ensures a secure connection, making it ideal for environments with vibration or movement, such as industrial, railway, or aviation systems . The fiber end is embedded in a 2.5 mm ferrule, typically made of zirconia ceramic or stainless steel, which provides precise alignment and low insertion loss . A key mechanism prevents the fiber from rotating during mating, maintaining signal integrity.

Polish Types

FC connectors are available with different polish styles, which affect optical performance:

- PC (Physical Contact): Slightly curved end face to reduce air gaps, with return loss around -40 dB .
- UPC (Ultra Physical Contact): More tightly polished for better return loss (~-50 dB), suitable for most digital and analog systems .
