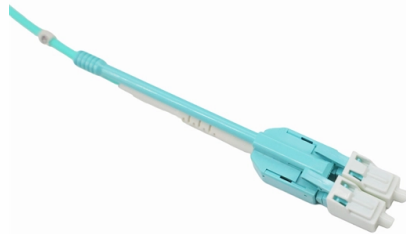

When trying to determine if your fiber optic cable is broken or experiencing issues, one of the simplest ways is to observe any physical damage or abnormalities in the cable. Breaks can result from external factors like excavation accidents (e., a backhoe cutting a 10 km backbone), environmental stressors.
