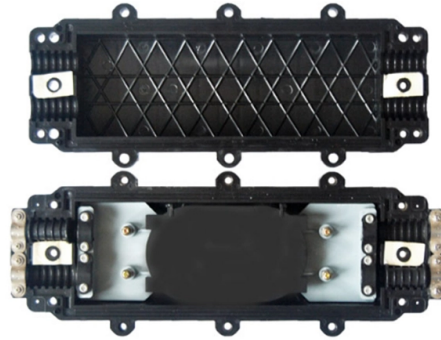


Fiber Optic Cable Blowing Construction
