Protective and Handling Materials

- **Protective Sheaths and Covers:** Used to shield the cable from mechanical damage, moisture, and environmental exposure during storage and installation .
- **Plastic Sheets:** Placed under cable ends during laying to keep them clean and prevent contamination .
- **Inner Ducts:** Smooth-walled conduits that allow fiber cables to slide easily and protect them from crushing or abrasion .

Installation and Pulling Equipment

- **Pulling Tape or Rope:** Used to pull the cable through ducts or conduits without stressing the fibers .
- **Breakaway Pulling Eyes:** Attach to the cable end to facilitate safe pulling and prevent fiber damage .
- **Automated Pullers:** Control tension and prevent twisting or kinking during cable deployment .
- **Cable Reels and Reel Stands:** Ensure smooth unwinding and prevent tangling or excessive bending .
