Types of Auxiliary Devices

- Sheaves and Rollers: Free-spinning sheaves allow the cable to wrap smoothly around drums or conduit bends, reducing friction and preventing kinks .
- Pulling Rod Accessories: Fiberglass rods and Polykat systems use specialized connectors and guides to extend reach and maintain alignment during installation .
